

# Streets and Streams: Our Baltimore Environment

Come explore the interactions between our urban ecosystem and the Chesapeake Bay. This five-day hands-on course focuses on how to engage your students in our local environment. Issues that will be investigated include land-use, polluted run-off, the cycle of matter and energy transfer, and water quality. Examine how our personal and communal decisions affect the rivers of the Chesapeake Bay through the collection, analysis, and interpretation of authentic data. All topics are designed to connect your students to their environment. Participants will take home an array of activities and lessons that can be incorporated into the school curriculum.



**When:** June 26<sup>th</sup> – 30<sup>th</sup>

**Where:** 5 field-based day in the Baltimore region.

**Cost:** \$50 registration fee. \$500 Stipends are available for participation.

**Credit:** Completing the course qualifies a participant to earn 3 CPD credits from MSDE.
